- 1. St. Maries Saddle Club, the Benewah County Fairgrounds, their officials, associates, membership, and directors will not be held responsible for any accident that may occur or be caused to or by any horse exhibited at this show or for any article of any kind that may be lost or damaged. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned, exhibited or in his/her custody or control shall indemnify and hold harmless the above named organizations, their officials, or directors individually and collectively form and against all claims, demands, causes of action causes of action, costs, charges, And expenses of every kind whatsoever arising out of which may be incurred by reason of any accident, injury, or damage to person or property causes by ownership, exhibition, custody, or control of any animal exhibited. The owner, rider, and any of their agents/representatives acknowledge that they participate voluntarily in the competition full aware that horse sports and competitions involve dangerous risk, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risk, injury, and loss and they agree to hold harmless the competition and the officials, directors, employee, and agents for the injury or lose suffered during or in connection with the competition, whether or not synch injury or lose resulted directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of the said officials, directors employees, and agents. ALL HORSES EXHIBITED WILL BE AT OWN RISK!
- 2. Contestants are responsible for knowledge of all show rules. Presentation of signed entry blank shall be deemed acceptance of said rules. If failure of sign entry, first entry into the show ring as an exhibitor will be deemed as acceptance of said rules and all show rules.
- 3. Entries must be made on an official entry blank or copy and must be signed by proper parties. Entry fees must accompany the entry blank.
- 4. Any exhibitor making a protest should lodge a protest in writing to the show secretary within 1 hour of protest. Protests will be adjudicated by a protest committee of the show officials not involved in the protest.
- ***The following are not protest-able: judges' decisions on the lameness of a horse.
- 5. ALL PETS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. NO DOGS ALLOWED TO ADJACENT TO THE ARENA WHILE CLASSES ARE IN PROGRESS.

- 6. The show reserves the right to refuse entry because of disrespect for the rules, intoxication and rough treatment of animals or for any other reason the management may deem necessary.
- 7. Gate holds will be granted only if requested at the office at least three classes prior to the one being requested for.
- 8. The age of the exhibitors will be determined by their age of Jan. 1st of the current year.
- 9. While in competition all exhibitors shall wear numbers on their back or both sides of the saddle pad. All exhibitors shall appear in the ring property attired according to the rule of that particular class.
- 10. NO ONE shall approach the judge with regards to a decision unless he/she first obtains permission from the show committee to show ring steward, who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at the proper time and place. No exhibitor has the right to inspect the judges' cards without his/her permission. **THE JUDGES' DECISIONS SHALL BE FINAL IN ALL CLASSES.**
- 11. Walk/trot class is designed for horses of any age and/or beginner type rider. Cannot have placed in any pleasure classes. No cross-entry allowed. Walk/trot is not a point class but there will be an award for the class.
- 12. No stallions are to be handled/ridden by exhibitors under the age of 18.
- 13. All riders under the age of 18 MUST WEAR A HELMET!
- 14. Reigning class will have added money to the jackpot as long as there are 2 or more riders.
